### Instructions for after your test

Call us right away if you have any of these symptoms in the next 7 days:

- Unusual abdominal pain, chest pain or shoulder pain
- Vomiting red blood
- Having black stool
- Ongoing nausea or vomiting
- A fever higher than 100°F (37.8°C)
- Difficulty swallowing

- You can resume your usual diet and medicines.
- **For your safety and the safety of others:**
  - Do not drive today. It is against the law.
  - Do not drink alcohol today.

### Your Test Results

- The results of your exam were normal.
- Biopsies* (tissue samples) were taken. Results will be sent to you in about 2 weeks.
- \_\_\_\_\_ *polyps* were removed. Results will be sent to you in about 2 weeks.
- A *cyst* (collection of fluid) was sampled.
- An area of bleeding or potential bleeding was treated.
- You have had a *sphincterotomy* (an incision into the bile duct or pancreatic duct sphincter).
- For the next 7 days, do **not** take pain medicines such as aspirin or blood-thinning medicines such as ibuprofen (Advil, Motrin) or naproxen (Aleve, Naprosyn). It is OK to take acetaminophen (Tylenol).
- Repeat this test ( \_\_\_\_\_ ) in \_\_\_\_\_ weeks/months/years.
