### *Instructions for after your endoscopic ultrasound*

Call us right away if you have any of these problems in the next 7 days:

- Unusual abdominal pain, chest pain or shoulder pain.
- Vomiting red blood.
- Having black stool.
- A fever above 100°F.
- Difficulty swallowing.

You can now start your usual diet and medications again.

You might have a mild sore throat for a few days.
