

After you return home after surgery, call the clinic nurse or doctor on call if you have any of these symptoms:

- Bleeding, swelling, or colored drainage from your wounds.
- Fever greater than 101°F.
- Persistent nausea or vomiting.
- Rash or itching.
- Diarrhea or constipation.
