

# **Lung Function Testing**

How to find us

This handout explains how to find Lung Function Testing at UW Medical Center in Seattle, Washington. It includes driving and parking directions.

## **Finding Our Clinic**


Lung Function Testing is on the 5th floor of the hospital (see map below).

#### From the Main Entrance

- When you enter the hospital, you will be on the 3rd floor. Follow signs to the Pacific elevators. Take the elevator to the 5th floor.
- Lung Function Testing is straight ahead as you leave the elevator.

## From the Triangle Garage

- After you park, walk through the tunnel to the hospital. When you enter the hospital, you will be on the 3rd floor.
- Follow signs to the Pacific elevators. Take the elevator to the 5th floor.
- Lung Function Testing is straight ahead as you leave the elevator.



★ Lung Function Testing is on the 5th floor, close to the Pacific elevators.

You may park in the Triangle Parking Garage or use valet parking at the main entrance to the hospital.

## Parking at UWMC

Park in the Triangle Garage or use valet parking at the main entrance to the hospital.

Patients can get validation for a reduced parking rate. You must have your parking ticket stamped to receive this discount. Please ask staff at the Lung Function Testing front desk for validation.

## **Triangle Parking Garage**

- This underground garage is across N.E. Pacific St. from UWMC. Enter from N.E. Pacific Pl., ½ block west of Montlake Blvd. N.E.
- A pedestrian (walking) tunnel leads from the garage to the 3rd floor (main level) of the hospital.
- The garage has 500 parking stalls, with 67 stalls for disability parking and 9 wheelchair-accessible stalls.
- Height restriction for vehicles is 6 feet, 8 inches.
- Pay as you leave.
- Garage parking is free on Sundays.
- You may park after hours. Parking is free if you enter the garage after 9 p.m. or leave between 1 a.m. and 6 a.m.
- Parking staff work weekdays from 6 a.m. to midnight and Saturdays from 7 a.m. to 4 p.m.

#### Directions from Interstate 5:

- Take Exit 168B (Bellevue/Kirkland) onto State Route (SR) 520.
- Take the first exit to Montlake Blvd. N.E. Turn left onto Montlake Blvd. Move into the left-hand lane.
- Cross the drawbridge and turn left onto N.E. Pacific St. Move into the right-hand lane.
- Turn right at the 2nd "Patient Parking" sign onto N.E. Pacific Place. Turn right into the Triangle Parking Garage.

#### Directions from State Route 520 westbound:

- Take the exit for Montlake Blvd. N.E.
- Merge onto Montlake Blvd. N.E. Move into the left-hand lane.
- Cross the drawbridge and turn left onto N.E. Pacific St. Move into the right-hand lane.
- Turn right at the 2nd "Patient Parking" sign onto N.E. Pacific Place. Turn right into the Triangle Parking Garage.

## **Disability Parking**

- The Triangle Garage has disability parking, including spaces for wheelchair vans.
- If you have disabilities and do not have an adaptive vehicle, you may use valet parking.

## **Valet Parking**

- Valet parking service is available at the main entrance to the hospital.
  Parking fees are the same as those charged for parking in the Triangle Garage.
- The valet cannot park adaptive vehicles.
- You may ask for a wheelchair and escort at valet parking.

## **In/Out Parking Access**

If you need to leave the hospital and return on the same day, ask the garage staff person for an in/out access card.

## **Parking Rates**

Patients can get validation from their clinic or nurses station to park at these reduced rates:

• 0 to 30 minutes: Free • 2 to 3 hours: \$9

• 30 minutes to 1 hour: \$3 • 3 hours or more: \$10 daily maximum

• 1 to 2 hours: \$6 • In/out access: \$10 a day

Please note that these rates are subject to change each July.

## **Shuttle and Bus Services**

#### **Health Sciences Express**

Health Sciences Express provides free shuttle service to help patients, families, caregivers, faculty, and staff travel between UWMC, the clinics at UWMC-Roosevelt, the UW Tower, and Harborview Medical Center.

There is also free shuttle service to Fred Hutchinson Cancer Research Center, Seattle Cancer Care Alliance, and Seattle Children's.

#### Metro

Metro provides regular bus service to UWMC on many routes, including 25, 43, 44, 48, 133, 167, 197, 271, 272, and 277. Express bus routes, including 48, 205, 540, 556, and 586, also stop at UWMC.
