Instructions for after your test

Call us right away if you have any of these problems in the next 7 days:

- Unusual abdominal pain or shoulder pain.
- Blood in your stool or black stool.
- A fever above 100°F.

If you received sedation:

- Do not drive today. It is against the law.
- Do not drink alcohol today.

Results:

Your gastroenterologist will send the results to your referring doctor or gastroenterologist.

- Normal exam.
- Repeat rectal EUS recommended in _____ months / years.
- A biopsy was taken. Results will be sent to you in 1 to 2 weeks.
