### 方向:

## 如您使用镇静剂

通常此程序是不需镇静剂的。我们也可为您提供镇静剂、让您选择;如您希望使用镇静剂、则:

- 午夜后不可进食。
- 在您预约前2小时可以喝透明的饮料。但此后即不可再喝任何 东西。
- 请在预约前30分钟到达。
- 安排一位能负责的家人或亲友带您回家。做检查那天您不能开车。如您来报到时没有一位能负责的成年人带您回家、就会取消您的检查。检查的时间约为 2 小时、那时您的家人或朋友必须在候诊室等您。您不可坐计程车、公车或接送公司 (如 Hopelink) 的车、除非有一位能负责的成年人与您一起乘坐。

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## 检查过程

已为您安排了做乙状结肠镜的检查。此检查可让您的医生看到乙 状结肠的内膜。做此检查医生将使用如手指一般粗细的软管由肛 门插入。

过程中您可能有一些痉挛感。您的医生可能会取样本做活检(组织的样品)、但您不会感觉到。

检查只需 10 分钟。因为准备及恢复需要时间,因此您在医院停留的时间会长一些。医生会告诉您检查的结果。如结果尚未出来,您的医生会告诉您何时会与您联系。

How to prepare

Your appointment at the Digestive Disease Center, on the 3rd floor of the Surgery Pavilion, is on:

Follow These Instructions to Prepare for Your Exam				
Buy these supplies at your local drugstore:				
☐ 1 bottle of Magnesium Citrate				
2 FLEET enemas				
The day before your exam at 5 p.m.:				
☐ Drink 1 bottle of Magnesium Citrate.				
The day of your exam:				
Starting 1 hour before you leave your house to come to your appointment, give yourself 2 FLEET enemas. Follow the directions on the box. Give yourself the enemas 1 at a time. After you expel the 1st enema, repeat with the 2nd one.				
Starting 1 hour before you leave your house to come to your appointment, give yourself 2 lukewarm tap-water enemas. After you expel the 1st enema, repeat with the 2nd.				
Bring a list of your medicines to your appointment.

### If You Have Sedation

This procedure is usually done without sedation, but sedation is an option. If you want sedation:

- Do not eat anything after midnight.
- You can drink clear liquids until 2 hours before your appointment time. After that, do not take anything by mouth.
- Arrive 30 minutes earlier than your appointment time.
- Arrange for a responsible family member or friend to take you home. You cannot drive on the day of your test. Your test will be cancelled or done without sedation if you arrive without a responsible adult to drive you home. Your family member or friend must be in our waiting room at the time of your discharge, about 2 hours after your appointment time. You cannot take a taxi, a bus or use an escort service (like Hopelink) unless you have a responsible adult to ride with you.

## **Special Instructions**

• If you have diabetes, your diabetes medicines will need to be adjusted. Please talk with your doctor to plan a schedule for your diabetes medicines for the day of your procedure.

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# What to Expect

You are scheduled for a sigmoidoscopy. This test allows your doctor to look at the lining of the last part of your large intestine. Your doctor will place a flexible tube in your rectum. The tube is about the size of a finger.

You might have some cramping during the test. Your doctor may take *biopsies* (tissue samples), but you will not feel this.

The procedure takes about 10 minutes. Your appointment will last longer because of preparation and recovery. Your doctor will talk with you about the results. If results are not ready right after the test, your doctor will tell you when you can expect to be contacted.

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
