

## **Before and After Your Procedure**

At the Sports Medicine Center at Harborview

Procedure:		
Please follow all the instructions that are marked below.		
Arrive before your procedure by:		
☐ 15 minutes		
☐ 45 minutes		
☐ 1 hour – for a blood draw or to start your <i>intravenous</i> (IV) line		
Driver or escort:	Arrive early, as marked.	
You must have a driver to bring you to the clinic and take you home.		
Having a driver is optional. If you drive yourself, you will need to wait 15 to 30 minutes after your procedure before driving.		
Your escort may drive you in a car, or yo taxi, shuttle, or other public transit.	ou may ride together in a bus,	
Eating and drinking:		
☐ You may eat and drink as usual.		
☐ Do <b>not</b> eat or drink anything for 6 hour	s before your procedure.	
Blood sugar:		
☐ Check your blood sugar the morning of or drinking simple sugars the day of you		
☐ We may check your blood sugar on the	day of your procedure.	
Medicines and vaccines:		
☐ Take your blood pressure or diabetes m	edicines as prescribed.	
☐ Bring your inhaler,	, with you.	
Stop taking vitamin and herbal products 7 days before your procedure.		
☐ Stop taking your anti-inflammatory med day(s) before your procedure.	dicine,,	

_	talk with your primary care provider (PCP).
	If you are taking HIV medicines, we will call the provider who prescribed your medicines to make sure it is safe for you to have the procedure.
	If your doctor tells you to take anti-anxiety medicine, take it before your procedure. (If you take this medicine, you <b>must</b> have a driver to bring you to the clinic and take you home.)
	If you begin taking antibiotics or you have a fever, call the clinic to reschedule your procedure.
	Do <b>not</b> get a vaccine for 2 weeks before or 2 weeks after your procedure.
Other:	
	We may place an <i>intravenous</i> (IV) line into your arm vein.

## **After Your Procedure**

Unless your care provider gives you other instructions:

- You may do your usual activities on the day after your procedure.
- · You may shower.
- Do **not** take a bath, swim, or sit in a hot tub for 48 hours.
- Do **not** apply direct heat or use a heating pad on the site for 48 hours.
- You may return to work the day after your procedure, unless you have a job that involves physical labor. Talk with your provider about this.
- Avoid physical therapy or intense exercise for 3 to 7 days. Ask your provider when it will be OK for you to resume exercise.
- The day after your procedure, resume taking medicines you stopped.
- Be aware that your symptoms may get worse before they get better.
- If you have a steroid injection, it may take 2 to 3 weeks for you to receive full benefit.
