

Clomid

Instructions and follow-up

This handout gives instructions to follow when taking Clomid. It includes information about follow-up labs and visits with your doctor.

How to Take Clomid

- Clomid comes in 50 mg tablets. Your dose is 25 mg, so you will need to cut the tablets in half.
- Take 25 mg Clomid (½ tablet) every other day, or as prescribed by your doctor.

Follow-up Labs and Doctor Visits

- After taking Clomid for 1 month, you will need to have your hormone levels checked:
 - We will provide a lab form for you to take with you to your local lab or the UWMC lab. You should not need to make an appointment.
 - Have your hormone labs drawn in the morning before 10 a.m.
- After taking Clomid for 3 months, you will have a semen analysis done:
 - We will schedule this visit for you at the Male Fertility Lab at UWMC.
 - If you do not have this visit scheduled, call 206-543-4671 to set up your appointment.
- Your doctor will want to see you 1 to 2 weeks after your semen analysis visit. At this follow-up visit, your doctor will talk with you about the results of your tests and explain your treatment options.
