- 2) To educate low-income, refugee, immigrant families and their communities' handout safe pregnancy, birth, and baby care practices through classes and workshops.



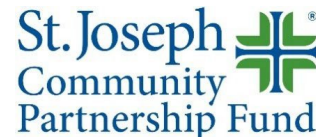
Core Values:
