The chance of complications (problems) related to this procedure is very low. However, it is important to know what to watch for and how to get help if needed.

Instructions:

- You can start eating your normal diet when swallowing feels comfortable.
- A mild sore throat is normal for a few hours. Throat lozenges may help.
- Follow all the instructions from your care team.

Warning Signs

Call us if you have:

- A temperature of 100.5° or higher
- Unusual chest or abdominal (stomach) pain
- Trouble swallowing or moving your neck
- Vomiting blood
- Blood in your stool
