Preventing falls on 6SA

Your safety is our top priority while you are in the hospital. Help us keep you safe.

You may be at risk of falling because of:

- Medicines you are taking
- Feeling tired, “groggy,” or confused
- Being in place you don’t know well
- Tripping on tubes or machines that you are connected to
- Changes in how often or how urgently you need to use the bathroom
- Not knowing how your illness might affect your physical ability



For your safety while you are in the hospital, please agree to:

- Use the call light **every** time you need to get out of bed
- Let a nurse help you when you move about, toilet, or shower
- Let us help you while you are in the bathroom
- Let your family help you **only** when your nurse says it is safe
- Wear socks or shoes that do not slip
- Stay connected to your telemetry box while out of a bed

Ask for help every time you need to get out of bed, reach for something, get dressed, or move about. We will be there to help you.
