

Parking Passes for Patients with Extended Length of Stay

At University of Washington Medical Center

This handout answers questions about parking passes for family members or other loved ones of patients who have been staying overnight in the hospital for at least 15 days in a row.

How many parking passes do I receive?

UWMC will provide **1 parking pass per day** to patients who have a hospital stay of 15 days or longer. You will continue to receive 1 pass each day until your discharge.

Who will be able to use the pass?

You will choose which family member or other loved one will use the pass.

Is there any cost to me?

The parking pass allows 1 person to park free for 1 day at the hospital.

How does it work?

The chosen family member or loved one must bring their parking ticket to the Patient Services Specialist (PSS) of the unit where you are staying. Depending on which parking garage is used, the PSS will:

- Provide a parking validation sticker and free parking ticket (for the **Triangle Garage**)
- Stamp the ticket (for the **Surgery Pavilion Garage**)

Please talk with the PSS of your unit if you have any other questions about parking passes.

Note: If you are discharged and then readmitted to the hospital, your length of stay starts over at day 1.



Patients who have been staying overnight in the hospital for at least 15 days in a row are entitled to 1 free parking pass per day for their family or other loved ones while they remain in the hospital.
